
Weather: High: 52, Low: 23 (With an occasional chance of snow)

From DIA or Denver Area: Take 1–70 west, approximately 130 miles to Exit 176. Follow the first roundabout under the bridge, then follow the signs going towards Lionshead. Turn right on South Frontage Road. Turn left onto West Lionshead Circle. Resort will be on your right.

Parking: Valet Option – Marriott Mountain Resort offers Valet Parking Only for \$10 per day plus tip.

Free Public Parking Option: You can drop off your luggage at the Resort and drive minutes to the Public Parking Structure in the Village. Catch the free shuttle directly in front of the parking structure and back to the Marriott Mountain Resort. Greeters will be there to direct you.

Free Shuttle While at the Resort: The free shuttle bus to Lionshead Village runs daily on a 20-minute loop. Shuttle stop is directly in front of the hotel entrance. Great way to see the Village or grab a bite to eat on Friday night.
